13. Closed primaries allow members of political parties to elect the candidate who will carry their banner without interference from those who don't share their values. By replacing closed primaries with the current "jungle primary," Ballot Measure 2 allows multiple candidates from a single party to proceed to the general election, increasing voter confusion, and potentially leading to adverse outcomes due to ballot exhaustion. Candidates can effect the same result as closed primaries if they pledge to withdraw if they come in behind another member of their own party in the primary.
