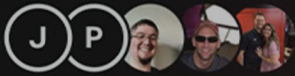

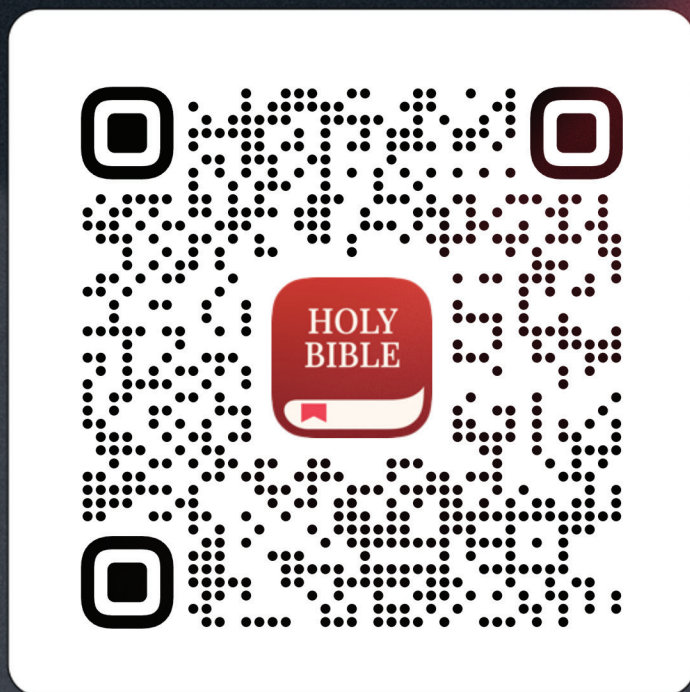

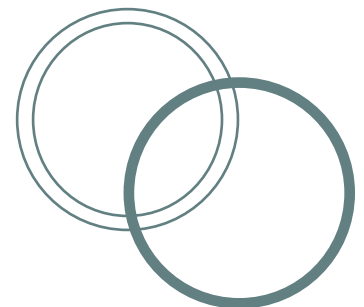

WHAT IS A GROUP?

Groups are a place where people have the opportunity to pursue authentic relationships and spiritual growth. When you join a group, you will spend time socializing, learning, and praying together. All you have to do is show up, join in, and be real. Groups meet throughout the week.

WHY JOIN A GROUP?

We want everyone at Mountain City Church to experience the deep, healthy community that we read about in the New Testament - it's what we were made for and why we believe circles are better than rows. We are committed to caring for the spiritual health of the body of Christ by creating and strengthening opportunities for biblical community for every group member. While we are a large church, groups offer the family relationships of a small church community so that no one slips through the cracks.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT IN A GROUP?

All groups will look a little different, yet all will include 3 essential elements.

1. All groups commit to building biblical community. To care for one another well, we must know one another. We spend time together and build communities that care for both physical and spiritual needs
2. All groups will be discussing biblical truths in order to help you grow spiritually. The specific study will often vary by group depending on the focus of the group.
3. All groups commit to deeper sharing and prayer. We spend time sharing how we are really doing, supporting one another, and praying for and with each other. We send each other out to make disciples.

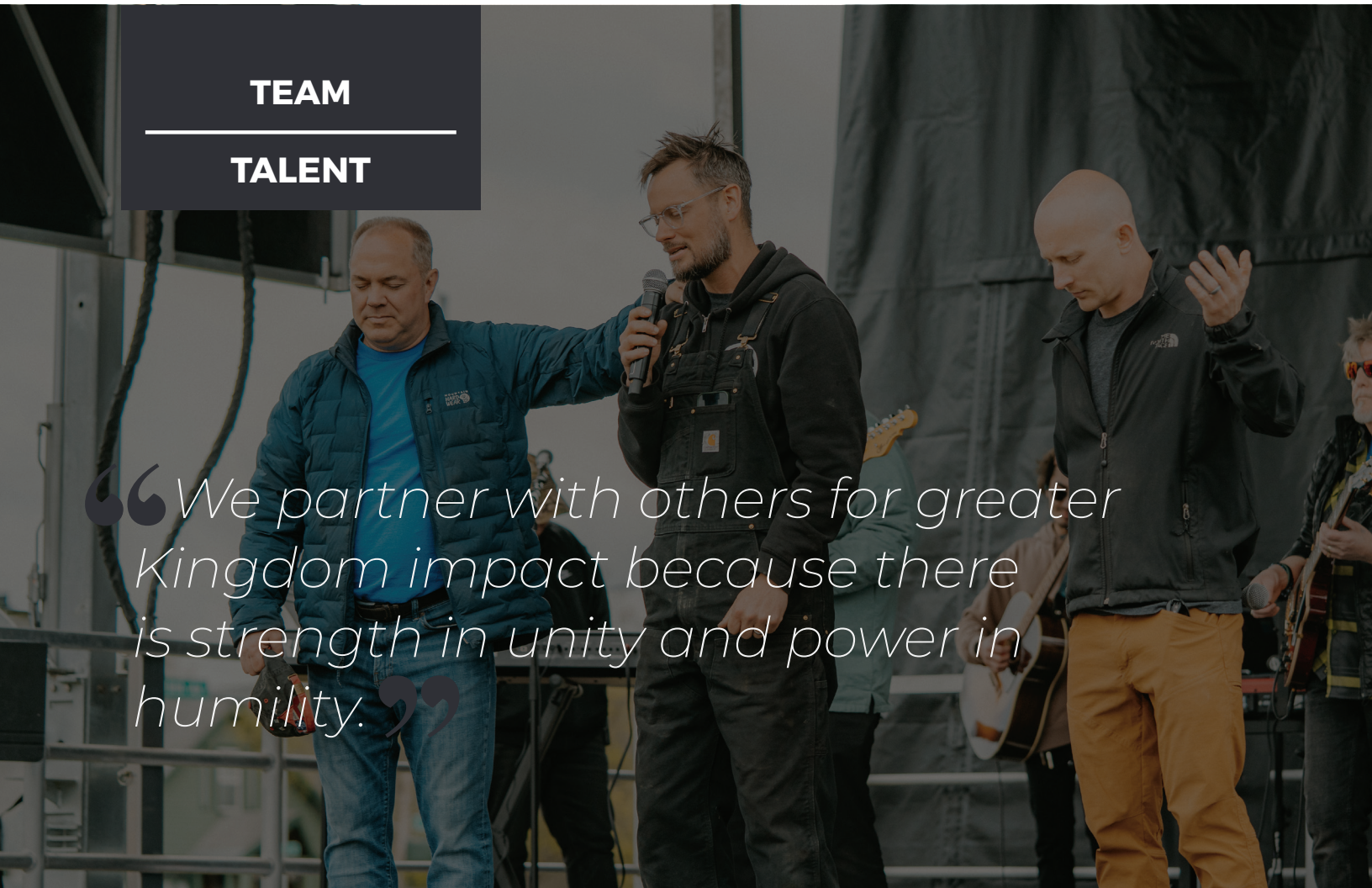
